

Albert Ave Lido, Hull

For my third road trip this season we visited the newly refurbished and recently reopened Albert Ave lido in Hull. The lido which was derelict for many years forms part of this fully refurbished facility with an indoor pool and gym onsite. As you would expect everything is state of the art with brilliant showers, good disabled access and a changing village. Parking is free and easy right outside the door.

There was no early start on this one as the lido doesn't open until 10.00am and they run several sessions throughout the day. However, if you are planning to visit my advice would be to pick your day with a good weather window and phone the centre before travelling to make sure that the lido will be open, as from what I could gather, on a wet day they transfer customers to the indoor pool and make decisions on a day to day basis.

At present they only run open to all sessions, there is no pre booking, you just turn up and pay on the door with a first come first served basis. You could only swim widths too and it was quite busy but this didn't cause me any problems and I had a good swim.

Albert ave lido is a fantastic facility and without a doubt the warmest lido I have swum in. It is 38m x 25m. Sadly they operate a no photos on poolside policy. As I've said previously, some Lidos do, others don't and you just have to accept and respect their individual policies.



I would fully recommend a visit to Albert Ave lido to other swimmers.
